


# SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS ON NEW JERSEY AVENUE NW (FROM H STREET NW TO N STREET NW)



## PROJECT BACKGROUND

Safety Improvements on New Jersey Avenue NW project was developed and designed based on the Mount Vernon Triangle Transportation and Public Realm Design completed in 2012, that recommended converting New Jersey Avenue NW to two-way operations. This project will address safety concerns in the corridor and improve access for other modes including transit vehicles, cyclists and pedestrians.

## PROJECT OBJECTIVE

The project objective is to improve the safety and comfort of New Jersey Avenue NW from H Street NW to N Street NW for all right-of-way users, while ensuring improvement to neighborhood connectivity and mobility for all modes within this project area. Improvements will include channelization at the intersections of New Jersey Avenue NW and New York Avenue NW, and New Jersey Avenue NW and 2nd Street NW/I Street NW to support two way operations. **Improvements will also include the reconstruction of New York Avenue NW (1st Street NW to 4th Street NW).**
